POSITION SUMMARY

The role of the Sherwood Park – Strathcona County PCN Registered Nurse (RN) is to work collaboratively with the patients, family physicians, other team members to provide comprehensive care in a family practice clinic setting. The RN will assess patients, develop, implement, and evaluate care plans for patients and provide indirect support to patients. The RN will work to full scope of practice with an emphasis on providing comprehensive care, education, and guidance to patients with chronic disease.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work collaboratively in a patient centred, integrated team-based practice within a primary care setting.
 - Provide comprehensive nursing services and care to patients in the family practice setting.
 - Act as a nursing resource to other multidisciplinary team members, healthcare institutions and community agencies or programs.
 - Assessment of patient conditions, needs and goals in collaboration with the patient, attending physician and interdisciplinary team
 - Identify needs and set priorities in collaboration with the client and other team members
 - Conduct assessments, initiate and implement management strategies and provide appropriate follow-up
 - Make professional, competent and autonomous decisions with patients as a member of the multidisciplinary team.
 - Provide relevant patient education to prevent and manage clinical conditions
 - Provide short term interventions as needed
 - Facilitate appropriate referrals to community resources and programs

 - Ensure the maintenance of accurate records in line with practice policy
